

## Adult Recognitions GSSNE's HALL OF FAME AWARD

Description

Hall of Fame Award recipients are selected by GSSNE's CEO. The award recognizes a lifetime of commitment to the Girl Scout movement within the GSSNE Pathway. The recipient has supported GSSNE in a variety of ways including volunteering at the Service unit level, serving on a council board, task group or committee, and financially supporting GSSNE. Recipients of this award are specifically chosen by GSSNE's CEO.

Criteria

MEMBERSHIP: The candidate is a currently registered member of GSSNE in

good standing and successfully completed all applicable

training

FOCUS: Service benefits at least one service unit or geographical

area within council jurisdiction

LENGTH: A minimum of 20 years through 9/30 of this calendar year

REQUIREMENTS: Candidate has served GSSNE as a volunteer at the service

unit level, served on a council board, task group, committee,

or as a national delegate, and is a donor.

Nomination

NOMINATION: 1 from GSSNE's CEO only

**ENDORSEMENTS:** none required

Nominee Example A long-time volunteer who has led Girl Scout Troops, served as a council and national delegate, served on the highest awards committee, is an annual donor, and volunteers at council to mentor new troop leaders. She embodies the true spirit of Girl Scouting and is generous with her enthusiasm for the movement.
