You may use Rhode Island, Massachusetts or Connecticut for this patch. Patches are available for all three states from the GSSNE shop.

Daisies should complete 4 activities.

Brownies should complete 6 activities.

Juniors should complete 8 activities.

Cadettes, Seniors & Ambassadors should complete 10 activities.

- 1. Recognize your state flag and what it symbolizes. Are there special colors or symbols in your flag? What do they represent? Make a state flag of your own.
- 2. What year was your state admitted into the Union, i.e., when did it become part of the United States?
- 3. Visit a state park or national monument in your state and learn about its history and features.
- 4. Visit your State House. If possible take a tour of the State House with a tour guide.
- 5. Who were the original settlers in your state? Why did they come to the area and where did they come from?
- 6. Find a recipe for a typical food from your state. Prepare it for your troop/group.
- 7. Learn more about your state. Find out the state motto, the state flower, the state bird, the state drink, the state tree, the state shell, etc. You might want to decorate a poster with these items and display it in your community.
- 8. Take a hike in your state and make a list of things you feel make your state special.
- 9. What is your state's nickname?
- 10. Find out about a famous woman or man in your state (past or present). Design a bookmark with her/his information and distribute them in your community.
- 11. Who are your state's neighbors? Find them on a map.
- 12. How many cities and towns are there in your state? Chose one and find out more about it.
