GSUSA's HONOR PIN

Description

The GSUSA Honor Pin recognizes a volunteer's significant contributions to meeting one or more council goals in membership growth and retention, fund development, or increased community visibility in **two or more** geographic areas within council jurisdiction and supports the delivery of the Girl Scout Leadership experience (GSLE).

Criteria

MEMBERSHIP: The candidate is a current registered member of GSSNE in good standing and has successfully completed all applicable training for the position(s) held

FOCUS: Service benefits at least two GSSNE service units or geographical areas

LENGTH: A minimum of 3 years through 9/30/22

REQUIREMENT: GSUSA Appreciation Pin recipient

Nomination

NOMINATION: 1 from any GSSNE member

ENDORSEMENTS: 3 from other GSSNE members familiar with the candidate's service. At least one endorsement letter must be from an adult not related to the candidate.

Nominee Example

A volunteer who implements a series of events and activities that brings girls together from different parts of the council leading to increased retention in those areas.

A volunteer or staff member who directs a membership outreach task group that results in a significant increase in girl or adult membership in underrepresented populations in several areas of the council.

A training manager or trainer whose events for an area of the council receive consistently high ratings resulting in increased participation by adults from several geographic areas.
