GSSNE's KIT HAMMETT AWARD

Description

Registered adult member who has held **two or more positions for two or more years** exceeding the expectations held for the positions, benefits **one or more geographical areas** within council jurisdiction, and contributes to council goals and objectives.

Criteria

MEMBERSHIP: The candidate is a currently registered member of GSSNE in good standing, held/holds two or more volunteer roles, and successfully completed all applicable trainings

FOCUS: Service benefits one or more GSSNE service units or geographical areas

LENGTH: A minimum of 2 years through 9/30/22

Nomination

NOMINATION: 1 from any GSSNE member

ENDORSEMENTS: 2 from other GSSNE members familiar with the candidate's service. At least one endorsement letter must be from an adult not related to the candidate.

Nominee Example

A service unit product program coordinator and troop leader for two years has worked with community partners to increase service unit cookie sales by 20% year-over year by expanding cookie booth opportunities and getting permission for signage to be placed at partner locations. The new community partnerships also resulted in additional meeting space for troops and service units benefitting the entire Girl Scout community. The volunteer's troop of older girls holds coaching sessions for younger girls just starting their cookie businesses which has increased their sales as well.
