All adult nominees MUST meet the following criteria:

- ✓ Be an active, registered adult Girl Scout member in good standing with Council. **
- ✓ Completed all of the required training or the equivalent for his/her role.
- ✓ Service performed has been above and beyond expectations for their position.

GSSNE's Special Supporter Award	Awarded to honor a group or individual who has shown outstanding support to Girl Scouts in a GSSNE community. The candidate need not be a registered member of GSSNE.	Length of Service: No minimum Nominations: 1 Endorsements: None required
GSSNE's Rising Star Award	Recognizes a first- or second-year volunteer who hit the ground running and made an immediate and significant impact on Girl Scouts.	Length of Service: 6-18 months Nominations: 1 Endorsements: 1
GSSNE's Guiding Star Award	Recognizes a GSSNE volunteer who mentors other Girl Scout adults, supporting their growth and success.	Length of Service: 1-year minimum Nomination: 1 Endorsements: 1
GSUSA's Appreciation Pin	Recognizes a volunteer for outstanding service in support of delivering the Girl Scout Leadership Experience to one service unit or geographic area and helps reach and surpass the mission-delivery goals of the area.	Length of Service: 1-year minimum Nomination: 1 Endorsements: 2
GSUSA's Volunteer of Excellence Award	Recognizes volunteers who performed beyond expectations of role while partnering directly with girls in any pathway using the National Program Portfolio OR providing significant support to the council's mission in areas such as membership, volunteer support, program, leadership, fund development, or council services.	Length of Service: 1-year minimum Nomination: 1 Endorsements: 2
GSSNE's Kit Hammett Award	Recognizes a volunteer who has held two or more positions with GSSNE for two or more years exceeding the expectations held, benefits one or more service units within council jurisdiction, and contributes to council goals and objectives.	Length of Service: 2-year minimum Nomination: 1 Endorsements: 2
GSUSA's Honor Pin	Recognizes a volunteer's significant contributions to meeting one or more council goals in membership growth and retention, fund development, or increased community visibility in two or more geographic areas within council jurisdiction and supports the delivery of the Girl Scout Leadership Experience (GSLE).	Length of Service: 3-year minimum Nomination: 1 Endorsements: 3 Prerequisite: GSUSA Appreciation Pin Recipient
GSSNE's Heritage Award	Recognizes a GSSNE volunteer's work to promote the history of Girl Scouts through artifact preservation, restoration, sharing and/or presenting the history of council and/or the entire Girl Scout movement.	Length of Service: 5-year minimum Nomination: 1 Endorsements: 3
GSSNE's Mira Hoffman Award	Recognizes an unwavering commitment to the Girl Scout movement with a focus on the outdoor experience. The recipient has made outstanding contributions to the council's work and consistently displays the finest spirit of Girl Scouting.	Length of Service: 5-year minimum Nomination: 1 Endorsements: 3
GSUSA's Thanks Badge	Recognizes a volunteer whose ongoing commitment, leadership, and service have had an exceptional measurable impact on meeting the mission-delivery goals and priorities of the entire council or the entire Girl Scout movement.	Length of Service: 5-year minimum Nomination: 1 Endorsements: 4
GSUSA's Thanks Badge II	Recognizes a volunteer who has previously received the Thanks Badge and has continued to contribute to the same high level for an extended period of time, or has increased their sphere of influence, or has used their skills to move into other fields of endeavor.	Length of Service: 8-year minimum Nomination: 1 Endorsements: 4
GSSNE's Hall of Fame Award	Award recipients are selected by GSSNE's CEO. The award recognizes a lifetime of commitment to the Girl Scout movement within the GSSNE Pathway. The recipient has supported GSSNE in a variety of ways including volunteering at the Service unit level, serving on a council board, task group or committee, and financially supporting GSSNE.	Length of Service: 20-year minimum Nomination: by GSSNE's CEO This award may be presented posthumously.
GSUSA's Milestones of Membership	This pin recognizes the total number of girl and adult membership years; presented in 5-year increments.	Length of Membership: 5-year minimum GSSNE will inform nominees by April 1.
GSUSA's Years of Service Pin	This pin recognizes an adult volunteer for their years of active volunteer service to GSSNE; presented in 5-year increments.	Length of Service: 5-year minimum GSSNE will inform nominees by April 1.
GSSNE's Ruth Haslegrave Award	The Ruth Haslegrave Milestones of Membership is a self-nominating award presented for 75 years of youth and adult membership with Girl Scouts of Southeastern New England.	Length of Service: 75-year minimum Nomination: may be submitted by the candidate or a colleague, and qualification will be determined by the GSSNE Adult Recognition Committee.
